We are proud to be launching our first ever Baycel Federal Credit Union Scholarship. Up to four scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each will be awarded to local graduating high school seniors committed to continuing their education at a college, university, or trade school.

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a Baycel member with an account opened prior to or by December 31, 2022;
- Be a graduating high school, or homeschool, senior student in Matagorda County;
- Complete all sections of the application including a typed essay of approximately 500 words based on the topic and questions provided on the last page;
- Provide a copy of your current transcript – include any college credits and SAT/ACT scores;
- Turn in your completed application and all accompanying documents to your high school counselor by 3:00 PM Friday, April 14th.

Recipients will be notified by the end of April and will be recognized by Baycel representatives at their respective high school awards assembly held in May. Scholarship funding will be issued to the Bursar's Office at the recipient's college once proof of enrollment and course registration for the first college semester is provided.
